Bill On His Own (TV 1983)

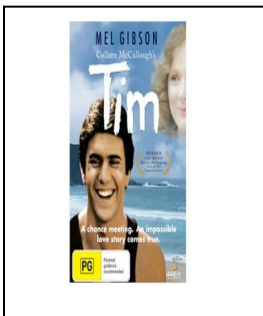

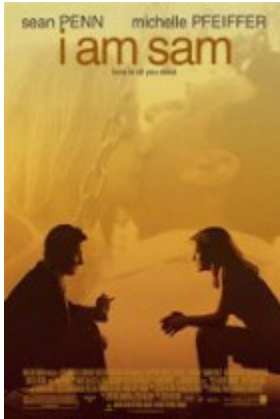
Radio (2003)
