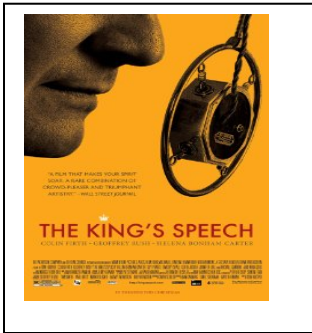


# SPEECH IMPAIRMENT OR NO SPEECH
